

When Life Changes . . . Call HealthSource RI

Did you know that federal regulations allow HealthSource RI to offer special enrollment periods (SEPs) to individuals and families who go through life changes that affect their ability to get healthcare coverage?

Our open enrollment period for individuals and families is closed until November, 2015. However, if something changes in your life, you might be able to enroll in healthcare coverage now. Check the list below to see if you might qualify for a Special Enrollment Period:

- **You've lost your health insurance through a job:** If you leave a job where you were provided health insurance, or have been let go from a job where you received health insurance, you likely qualify for a SEP.
- **Your employer changes the coverage available to you:** If your employer discontinues your health insurance or changes the coverage offered and you're allowed to terminate that plan, you may be eligible to enroll in a new plan during a SEP.
- **Your household size has changed:** If you have a new husband/wife, birth, adoption or foster care placement, your family likely qualifies for a SEP.
- **You're new to Rhode Island:** If you've just moved here from out of state and don't have access to qualifying employer coverage, you may qualify for a SEP.
- **Your immigration status has changed:** You must be a U.S. citizen or be lawfully present in the U.S. to buy insurance through HealthSource RI. If your immigration status has recently changed, you may be eligible to enroll in coverage outside of the open enrollment period.
- **You're too old to be covered by your parents:** If you've been covered on your parents' policy, but have turned 26 years old, you're eligible to enroll in your own coverage during a SEP.
- **You're no longer covered by another government health insurance plan:** If you were covered by RIte Care/Medicaid or veterans/military coverage but you are losing that coverage, you likely qualify for a SEP.

We know there are other changes that can affect coverage, too.
